## PROGRAM AIMS

The **Social Work Degree** aims to provide students the necessary knowledge to develop functions such as: information and orientation, prevention, assistance, planning, promotion and social insertion, mediation, supervision, evaluation, management, research and coordination. The formation is orientated to give the students the capacity if:

- To intervene in the social and institutional contexts where individuals, families, groups, organizations and communities live, assisting, tackling conflicts, performing tasks of mediation, help, education, defense, animation and changing these contexts, including political-social.
- To take part in the creation and evaluation of politics, services and social initiatives.
- To contribute to active citizenship through "empowerment" and the guarantee of human and social rights.
- To work in the social problems' prevention. The main objective is to contribute with other professionals to:
  - Social integration of individuals, families, groups, organizations and communities.
  - The constitution of a cohesive society
  - The development of the life's quality and social welfare.

## STRUCTURE

The program is divided in **6 modules**:

**Module A** (60 ECTS): Social work: concepts, methods, theories and application.

**Module B** (30 ECTS): The institutional context of social work.

**Module C** (54 ECTS): Processes and problems on which social work takes part.

**Module D** (18 ECTS): Legal and organizational tools for social work.

**Module E** (53 ECTS): Practices and Undergraduate Dissertation (TFG).
