

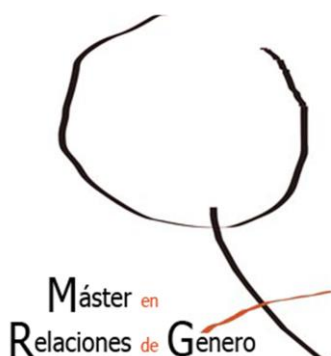

PROGRAM AIMS

This **Official Postgraduate Program** aims to provide a framework for reflection and debate from which to investigate the consequences that lead to the maintenance of inequality between women and men. Although it is oriented to an **academic specialization**, it includes the initiation in **research tasks** in this field of study and, in this sense, it will facilitate to those who attend it the access to the Doctoral Thesis, as long as they fulfill the requirements established by the current regulations.

The **training objectives** of this Master are:

1. Train students through the **acquisition of cognitive skills** and specific attitudes within the topic of gender relations.
2. The access from an **interdisciplinary perspective**, to the theoretical framework that clarifies the concepts and helps to understand different processes, more significant in relation with gender relations.
3. Go into detail about the negative conditions and consequences of **gender inequality**, to train in research and to develop research projects that discover, analyze and reflect on gender inequalities, avoiding androcentric perspectives, and develop strategies to influence the need to build a better world.
4. Make aware of the need to remove **social, political and economic obstacles** that stop the existence of a fairer and equal world.
